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**AROMA**

blackberry, lavender, crushed stone

**FLAVOR**

Italian plum, sun-baked herbs, lilac

**FOOD PAIRINGS**

Korean bbq, lamb meatballs w/ red sauce, tacos al pastor

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**VINIFICATION**

All fruit was hand-harvested and meticulously sorted in mid-Sept/early Oct. Fermented in a mix of open-top tanks with light cap management and T-bins beneath a "submerged cap." Once pressed, all lots aged for 10-months before bottling.

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**SITE**

Composed from a few historic Mendocino County ranches—some on the valley floor, some at high elevation—all with heritage dry-farmed, head-trained Carignan vines. Soils range from red clay (valley) to hardscrabble rocky soils (mountain). This rapidly vanishing California grape variety harkens back to the Golden State's earliest winemaking efforts.
